Who: Equine riders only

Base Camp: Valle Tio Vince's campground. There are 8 pipe horse corrals; some pens are quite rocky.

Riding during the day: multiple options – CDT in both directions and Mangas Mountain

We will provide: Tools, hard hats, trail and safety training, project supervision, and a first aid kit with Wilderness First Aid-trained personnel.

Vehicle Requirement: 2wd

Elevation: 7700 - 9700

Nearest Town: Quemado – but nearest Hospital is Springville, AZ



Weather: Come prepared with layers. Mornings and evenings may be cool.
Days will likely be warm to hot.

Directions from Silver City: Go to Reserve, go east on 12 to the Bursum Rd intersection, go left(North) onto 214/A95, go approximately 7-8 miles on the dirt/gravel road, Valle Tio Vines in on the left right next to the road.

Schedule:

Schedules are flexible and dependent on the volunteers' condition and energy level. Frequent breaks are encouraged. GBCH encourages volunteers to work within their limitations and take care of themselves during the project. Please check the weather in your project area prior to leaving for the project and pack accordingly.
