6/13/25 – Mimbres River Trail #77 – Barely flowing at the first crossing. [Photo](#) upstream, [photo](#) downstream.
5/18/26 – McKnight Canyon along the McKnight Trail – flowing – plenty of water
5/20/26 – Trail leaving from Railroad Canyon campground has only pools
2/27/25 - #128 Railroad Canyon – light flow and pools with algae in the first mile of the trail

8/6/26 – flowing water in Little Creek about 1.2 miles above #789 junction - [photo](#)
6/20/26 – Langstroth Creek where it crosses trail #302 – flowing water
6/6/26 – Hobo Spring (33.30089, -108.62101) small pool below the trail - [Photo](#) and Little Hobo is dry
5/29/26 – Holt Spring and Spring near Camp Creek Saddle both have water
5/18/26 – Hobo spring ([photo](#))- 36" across - maybe 5" deep max - a little muddy - small clear water running off of where trail crosses spring. Little Hobo spring ([photo](#)) - very small pool of water - 2" deep by a foot across - Hobo is better.
5/2/26 – Upper part of Mogollon Creek (above Turnbo) - intermittent pools and flow
4/28/26 – Mogollon Creek where trail # 189 crosses– good flow
4/28/26 – West Fork Mogollon Creek at junction of # 189 and #224 – good flow
4/24/26 – Packsaddle canyon – **DRY**
4/24/26 White Creek, Langstroth and Rawmeat – all running where the trail crosses
4/24 and 4/19/26 – Iron Creek along the West Fork Trail #151 - flowing water running all the way to the Middle Fork
4/17/26 - Iron Creek Lake – small puddle
4/16/26 – Apache Spring (near Apache Cabin) – 1.5 deep clear pool, but no visible flow

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4/16/26 - ~4 inch deep with lots of algae but enough to dip from.

4/15/26 – White Creek – good flow for the whole length

4/14/26 – Turkey feather spring/creek – flowing intermittent and water in the spring box - [photo](#)

4/3/26 – water flowing 6.2 miles up Little Creek from #160. Water flowing next to the trail. [Photo](#)

4/1/26 – Turkey Creek from junction with Granite Peak trail to junction with Miller Springs Trail # 159 – intermittent flow.

3/20/26 – water along the CDT in Rocky Canyon about 2.5 miles north of highway 35 - [Photo](#)

3/17/26 – Whiterocks Tanks - **Dry**

3/15/26 - Intermittent flowing water in Turkey Creek downstream from Miller Springs Canyon and around Manzanita Canyon. [Photo](#) of water flowing from Mansanita canyon into Turkey Creek.

3/2/26 – good flowing water in most of Mogollon Creek

2/26/26 – water in Mckenna Tank

2/26/26, 2/5/26 and 1/24/26 - pools and flowing slightly in upper ring canyon

10/6/25 – water intermittently flows in Canyon Creek in the section with the trail. And some nice big flowing pools lower down the creek. See correct map of the trail: <https://caltopo.com/m/ATD4T51>

10/4/25 – Turkey Creek Trail #155 from Junction with Miller Springs Trail #159 to Little Springs on Little Creek - a handful of mud pools and at least one nice big clear one about half-way

10/6/25 and 9/19/25 – Rock Spring (near the junction of Holt Apache Trail #181 and South Fork Whitewater Trail #212) – shallow pool of water that has been consistent through the summer- [Photo](#)

9/30/25 – pools in chicken coop canyon along trail #30 - [Photo](#)

9/20/25 - Turkeyfeather Spring/creek - flowing starting about halfway between Turkeyfeather pass and West Fork (unmaintained trail though) - [photo](#)

9/20/25 - Iron Creek @ 151 south of Iron Creek Lake (33.37839, -108.56576) - good flow

9/19.25 - Iron Creek @ Middle Fork - good flow, clearer than middle fork

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9/19/25 – Tennessee Meadows (on South Fork Whitewater Trail # 212 above junction with East Fork Whitewater) – running water and good size pools - [Photo](#)

9/19/25 – Holt Spring – steady flow - [Photo](#)
